



Dr Konstantinos GEORGIADIS

Dr Konstantinos Georgiadis is the Honorary Dean of the International Olympic Academy (IOA), Professor at the Chair “Dimensions of Olympism” at the Department of Sports Organization and Management and dean of the Faculty of Human Movement and Quality of Life Sciences at the University of Peloponnese (since 2014), Director of the International Master’s Degree Program in Olympic Studies “Olympic Studies, Olympic Education, Organization and Management of Olympic Events” organized by the University of Peloponnese and the International Olympic Academy (since 2009). From 2010 to 2014 he acted as Vice-Rector of the University of Peloponnese. He has been elected member of the Executive Committee of the International Society of Olympic Historians (ISOH) since its foundation.

Holder of a doctorate in Sports Science from the Johannes Gutenberg Universität of Mainz, his fields of research include, amongst others, the history of the modern Olympic Movement, the revival of the Olympic Games, Olympic education, and the ethical and philosophical dimensions of Olympism.

Experienced in Olympic education and sports administration, he has been Dean of the International Olympic Academy since 1992, member of the IOC Olympic Education Commission (formerly Culture and Olympic Education) since 2000, member of the IOC Consultative Commission for the 1st Youth Summer Olympic Games in Singapore 2010, member of the 17-member Executive Board of the “Athens 2004” Organizing Committee for the Olympic Games, Scientific Director of the IOA (1989 - 1992).

Honored with the title of Emeritus Professor of the Capital Institute of Physical Education in Beijing (2006), he has also received the Vikelas Plaque (2007) by the International Society of Olympic Historians for his contribution to the Olympic research.
